This icon is for house exercises. House exercises are group exercises.



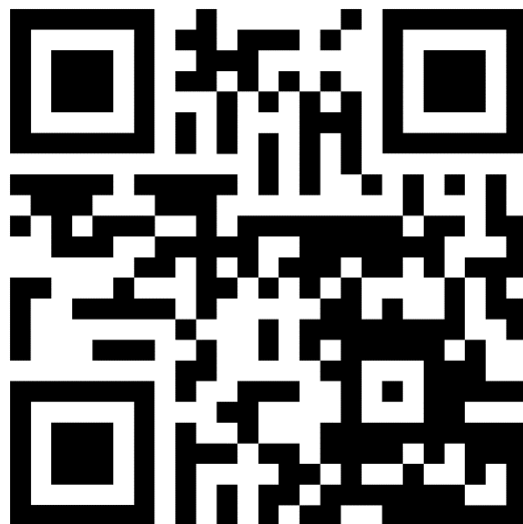
SORTING HAT

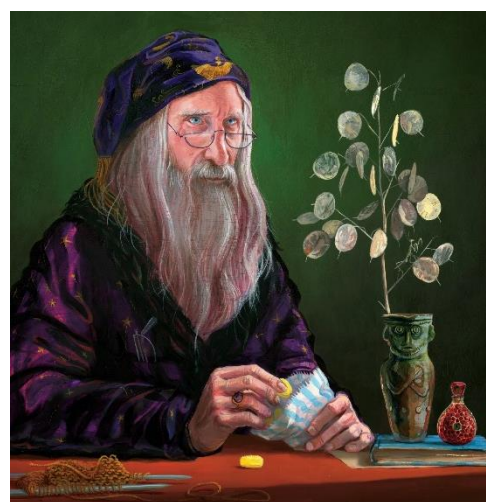

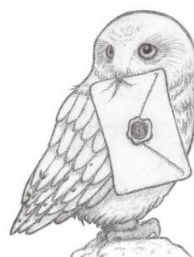
